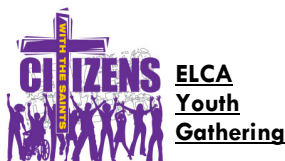
Soup Suppers

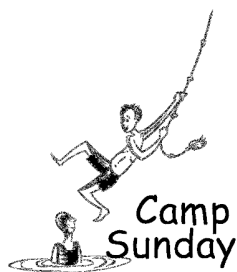
