

## PARENTS -THIS IS YOUR PART

### STEP 1: REGISTER

- Fill out a new registration form (one per family)
- Attend Faith Walk Orientation with your child, Wednesday, September 21 at 6:30 p.m. at Trinity Crossing
- \$20 donation per family

### STEP 2: VOLUNTEER

#### Wednesday Night Café:

We understand that Wednesday evenings are a busy time for families – especially parents just coming home from a long commute. Wednesday night café can help with feeding the family but we need volunteer families to cook, serve & clean up the café. Your gift of time **once** during the Faith Walk season is important in the operation of the café. Your expenses will be reimbursed and your family will get a home cooked meal. Sign up in the kitchen at the Faith Walk Orientation.

#### Mentoring:

During the Lenten season your child will be mentored by a person (of his/her choice) from our church family, together they will attend the Lenten services beginning on Ash Wednesday. There will then be a time for discussion after the service. Mentoring encourages our children to build a friendship with someone else in our church family that will help him/her grow in their faith. ### STEP 1: COMPLETE FAITH IN ACTION SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES

#### Acolyte

- Two Sundays per year. Sign in with the usher(s) to confirm your acolyte date and get proper credit.

#### Service Hours

- 6<sup>th</sup> Grade
  - 1 in service hour
  - 1 community service hour
- 7<sup>th</sup> Grade
  - 2 in service hours
  - 2 community service hours
- 8<sup>th</sup> Grade
  - 3 in service hours
  - 3 community service hours

#### In-Service Hours...

Anything you do inside the church. Sunday school aid, nursery helper, Parent Night Out babysitter, coffee hour assistant, reader, greeter, usher (with your family), special music, helping a committee or in the church office.

#### Community Service Hours...

Anything you do outside of the church. Help a neighbor, baby-sit (for free), volunteer to help a coach or at a school event. Help your grandparents (or an elderly neighbor) mow the grass, shovel the sidewalk or rake the leaves.

### Service Project Forms

- Forms must be completed by the student and signed by a supervising adult.
- Turn into the church office or your FW guide. *Credit will not be given if a form is not received in the church office.*
- Forms will be available at the orientation, from your guide, or on the youth bulletin board.

### Bulletin Notes

- 5 per year
- Fill out a sermon note form (green) they will be on the credenza.
- Turn into the bulletin note box found on the credenza in the narthex to receive credit.
- Bulletin notes not completed this year will be added to the next year.

### Lenten Youth Mentoring

Choose an adult from our church to mentor you during the Lenten season. If you cannot find an adult please talk to Pastor Marty.

### Camp Onomia

Attend camp one week out of the three years you are in Faith Walk. We attend confirmation camp in June each year at Camp Onomia. Join us for a week of good food, fun activities, and great fellowship.
