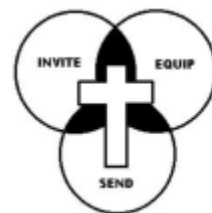
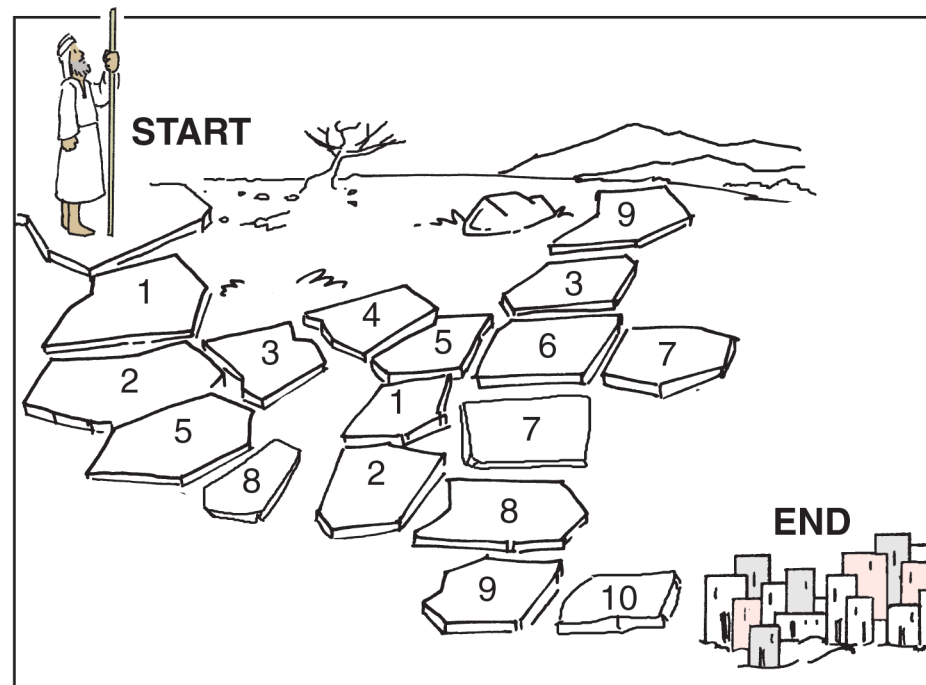

Follow the path to take Elijah to the city.

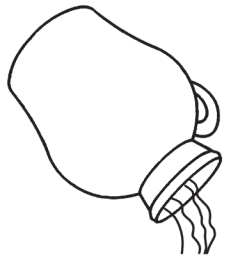

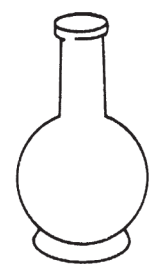
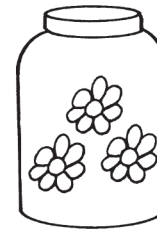
Bread
