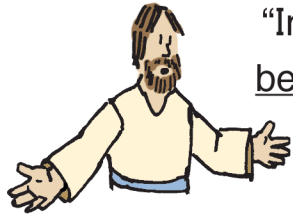


Jesus drew a comparison between the lamp in the house and the life of a believer.

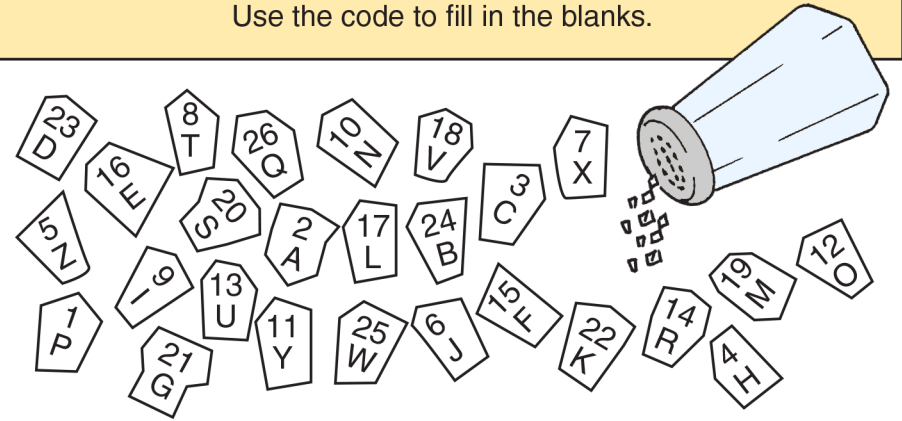

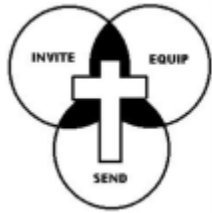
Jesus Speaks of Salt and Light

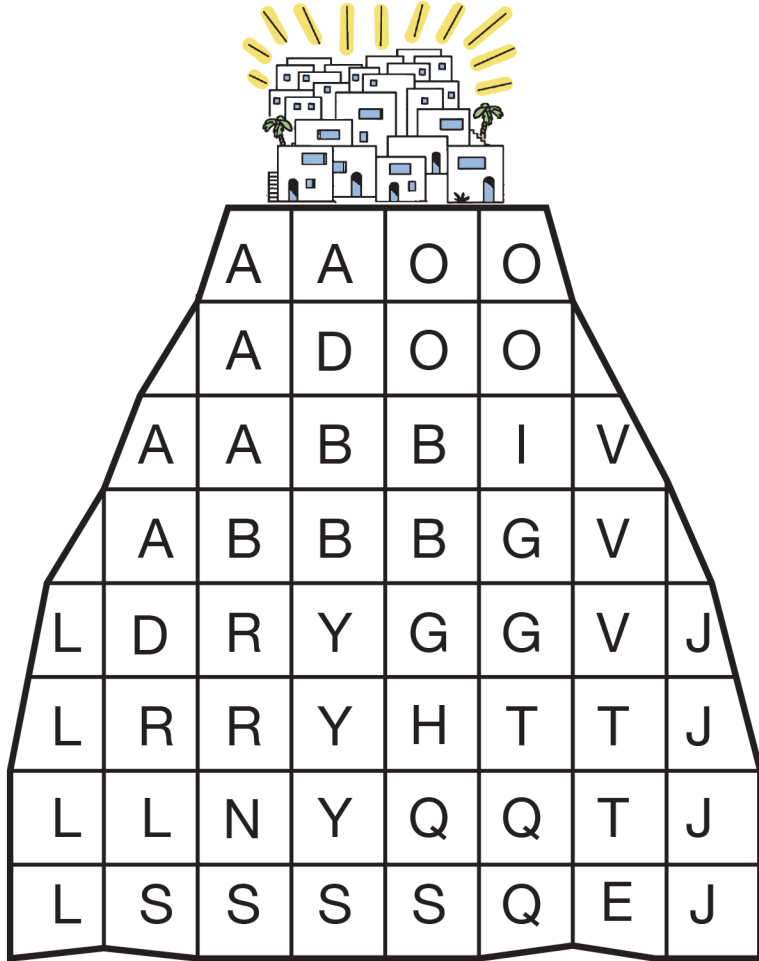
